

## THE SYNAXIS OF THE ANGELIC - LEADERS MICHAEL & GABRIEL AND ALL THE BODILESS POWERS

On November 8th St. Michaels Home celebrates its Name Day since it is the date our Church celebrates the Synaxis (Gathering) of the Angelic-Leaders Michael and Gabriel and all the Bodiless Powers. The facility bears the name of Archangel Michael while the chapel is dedicated to the "Taxiarchai" (another name for the Archangels). In the 4th Century A.D., Pope Sylvester and Patriarch Alexander established that there are 9 orders (ranks/categories) of Bodiless Powers: Archangels; Six-Winged Seraphim; Many-Eyed Cherubim; Thrones; Dominions; Virtues/Authorities; Powers; Principalities and Angels, each group with its own particular function and task. It was decided to designate a Feast Day in their honor and in accordance with the 9 orders of Bodiless-Powers, November was selected as it was the 9th month on the calendar during the early days of the Roman Empire. The 8th day was selected in conjunction with the Last Judgment of God which the holy Fathers called the 8th day since in the final age, when the 7 days of creation have elapsed, will come the 8th day and then "shall come the Son of Man in His glory and all the holy angels together with Him". (Matthew 25:31)

There are 9 known Archangels, each of whose name has special meaning: Michael - "who is like God; Gabriel - "the power of God"; Raphael - "the healer"; Uriel - "light of God; Salathiel - "one who prays to God; Jequdiel - "one who glorifies God"; Barachiel - "the blessing of God"; and Jeremiel - "salvation of God". As a doxology but also of prayer we fervently offer the Apolytikion/Hymn of the Archangels.

## Recipient of the 2025 Acrohangel Michael Award

#### MIKE & LIBBY ANGELIADES

Merkourios Athanasios Angeliades, known as Mike, was born in Symi, Greece on November 20, 1941. He came to New York on November 8, 1960, to pursue a better life for himself and his family in Greece. In 1965, he opened Magnetic Construction, doing mostly home improvements, restaurant renovations and city and state projects.

In 1970, he married Liberty Maris (Libby). He worked very hard, long hours, seven days a week. His perseverance resulted in his establishing M.A. Angeliades Inc. in 1991. His company grew into a multi-million-dollar organization, was listed in the top 400 construction firms in the United States for many years.

Today he is an owner of Kyma Roslyn, Hudson Yards, Flatiron and Elea. Currently he is building a Kyma in West Palm Beach expected to open in the Fall of 2025 and one in Stamford Ct. opening in 2026.

He also is the owner of a chain of drive – thru convenience stores called Dairy Barns, located in Long Island, NY.

In South Bend, IN he has converted a 26-floor building into an Aloft Hotel and is building 10 floors of residential apartments to be completed in the Fall of 2025. In Greece he has invested in many hospitality ventures, promoting tourism in Rhodes and Paros.

Mikes ambition, determination and extraordinary work ethnic has contributed to his success.

Libby and Mike are very proud of their heritage. Together they were founders and contributors to the Archangel Michael Greek Orthodox Church, serving

on the board for many years and starting the Greek Language Institute. Also, on the Board of The American Association of St. Catherines Foundation; Trustees of St. Nicholas National Shrine; Members of leadership 100; Members of Faith; Mike is a member of the Ahepa Gold Coast Chapter; has the honor of serving the Archons of the Ecumenical Patriarch of the Order of St. Andrew the Apostle.

As a result of many philanthropic endeavors, he has been honored by Sharing and Caring, The Guardian Angels, The Hellenic Medical Society, Cosmos FM, The Greek American Soccer Club and many civic and religious institutions.

Mike believes in and enjoys the simple things in life. He is a strong believer in never forgetting his roots. He loves returning to Symi every summer where he enjoys drinking ouzo with friends as they sit on the steps in front of his house and to have Symi shrimp at the local taverns. Everything Mike has ever done or strived for stems from his love of family. His initial motivation to be a success was to provide his family in Greece with a better life. He remains the sole provider for his sister (Theia Eirini) who was stricken by Polio at the tender age of 3. He is the most generous kind and loving father to his four daughters, Phaedra, Aegina, Irena and Ilana and his six granddaughters, Melina, Anastasia, Sophia, Electra, Athena and Mila and his two grandsons Mikey (Merkourios) and Matthew.

Anyone who knows Mike is often inspired by his story. It is a classic tale of man with a dream and the willingness to work hard and take chances.

## BUILDINGFORTHEFUTURE

#### Update on the Relocation & Expansion of St. Michael's Home

**NEED:** AAccording to the Census Bureau, the number of elderly 65 years and older in 2020 was close to 60,000,000 and represents the fastest growing segment of the population, expected to almost double in size the next 25 years. Of this group, 61% were 85-89, 30% were 90-94 and 10% were 95 & older. The US Dept. of Health projects that 70% of people 65 years & older will need long term care. That percentage increases exponentially with age. As more and more people live longer, their needs due to diminished health and mobility and/or cognitive acuity will dramatically increase the demand for facilities such as the new St. Michael's.

In previous generations, it was expected that children would care for their parents as they aged, but that it is no longer a realistic expectation even within our own community (the majority of the Home's current residents are between 85-102 years old. People are living longer so their children face challenges caring for themselves or are occupied helping raise grandchildren or have relocated elsewhere in the nation. More importantly, seniors especially those born in the U.S. do NOT want to live with and be a burden to their children so a facility like St. Michael's takes on added importance.

While offering an environment unrivaled in other similar facilities, St. Michael's, because of certain limitations, is forced to transfer to other facilities residents, who because of the aging process, require a higher level of care than the Home is licensed to offer. Moreover, applicants are often unable to be admitted for the same reason. This, at a time when these senior members of our community especially need the unique environment as well as the religious, cultural and emotional support which only the facility can offer.

**HISTORY:** To fully respond to these ever-increasing numbers and needs of our elderly, an 11-acre site with 4 interconnected buildings encompassing over 100,000 sq. ft was purchased in 2014 for \$7,000,000 with a downpayment of \$5,000,000 and a \$2,000,000 mortgage (currently \$1,400,000). Ater completing an extensive application process, the NYS Department of Health gave approval in November 2020 for the project to move forward. Begun in 2021, work though hampered by the PANDEMIC and INFLATION is now about 75% **complete**, with exterior renovations done and focus now on interior work. Installation of plumbing, electrical and HVAC are for the most part complete and the next stage of installing dry-wall and finishing touches is set to start once financing is available.

VISION: The "new" St. Michael's will accommodate over 150 residents (versus the 60 at the Yonkers location) and will offer progressively higher levels of licensed care (versus the single license now). Several of those licenses, including the approval of 35 Medicare/ Medicaid beds, have already been secured. This expansion will eliminate the need for a resident to leave for another institution and allow the Home to accept applicants not eligible for admissions at the Yonkers facility as their care-needs exceed those currently permitted. The completely renovated structure will include: independent-living one-bedroom & studio (rental) apartments; studio bedrooms/units for independent and progressive levels of assisted living as well as those in a secure Memory Care Wing for Alzheimer's and dementia residents. Also included is a Chapel, physical therapy room, computer & movie lounges, taverna, beauty salon and so many other spaces expected and needed in this day and age to provide an attractive, enjoyable and nurturing environment.

FINANCES: To date, pledges of over \$43,650,000 most of which have been fulfilled. There are outstanding pledges of \$1,986,000 which are "current" and scheduled to be fulfilled within 12 months. These figures do not represent site purchase and related costs and donations for it. Unfortunately, as with every construction project of this magnitude, the expansion has exceeded the time it was projected to take to complete as well as its cost. Both the pandemic and historic inflation have compounded the situation and if not for these issues, the project would have been done by now. While a \$10,000,000 construction loan has been secured and is available to complete the last stage of work, the Board is exploring other funding options to be able to not only complete construction but also provide the monies which will be needed for the first years of operation to sustain the new facility until it is operating at near or full capacity.

Certainly, the community has been most supportive of this critically needed facility, and the project would not be at this juncture if not for the magnanimous generosity of donors of large and small gifts. Yet, there are others who have not participated in the Capital Campaign, and it is hoped that as they find out about the project and see what has been accomplished, they will be motivated to support its completion. Certainly, there is an obligation to provide our seniors who represent this fastest growing segment of our population with an "elder care facility" offering a loving Greek Orthodox environment in which they receive ALL the assistance and levels of quality care they may need at this point in their life, especially religious, cultural and emotion support

















#### WHAT IS ENVISIONED IN THE NEW FACILITY




